

# THE MEANS OF ACCREDITATION TO TEACH IN A CATHOLIC SCHOOL

- (1) **Hours:** The applicants should be able to demonstrate that they have engaged in *fifty (50) hours* of study.
  
- (2) **The studies should include an adequate coverage of each of these areas:**
  - (a) Child, adolescent and adult faith development;  
*(a minimum of 10 hours)*
  - (b) The aims, objectives and rationale of Catholic schools;  
*(a minimum of 10 hours)*
  - (c) Revelation, the Catholic Church, Jesus Christ, Scripture, the Church in its Liturgy, Life and Tradition, Sacraments, Morality, Justice and Peace.  
*(a minimum of 15 hours)*
  
- (3) **These studies may be undertaken in:**
  - (a) School-based inservice activities
  - (b) Diocesan and regional seminars
  - (c) Formal courses
